

## UKRAINE BRIEFING: 12<sup>th</sup> September 2022

(Note: The Government uses the terms 'Sponsors' for UK households registering to accommodate Ukrainians and 'Guests' as Ukrainians registering to stay with sponsors. This briefing does likewise).

As of Monday 12<sup>th</sup> September at 10.00am, the Home Office online 'Foundry' portal shows that 1,447 (1,438 last Monday) Surrey sponsor households are matched with 4,260 (4,267 last Monday – we are trying to understand why this figure has gone down) Ukrainian guests under the Homes for Ukraine scheme, although this does not necessarily reflect the actual numbers of guests that will arrive. Trend data along with an approximate breakdown of this figure by District and Borough is given below at Annex A. As you will see the trend data shows the slowing of new applications as well as arrivals into the county.

These figures can be seen in a national context, as DLUHC publishes visa data received from the Home Office by local authority for the UK, relating to the Ukraine Family Scheme and Ukraine Sponsorship Schemes:

**Welfare and Safeguarding** Checks continue to ensure guests and sponsors are safe following their arrival on the Homes for Ukraine scheme. To date over 2,600 DBS checks have been started with only 19 containing information and the majority of these have had no impact on the ability of the sponsor to carry on with the scheme. There have been 8 cases across the county where guests have been rehoused due to welfare issues and all guests involved have been successfully rehoused and no further issues have been reported.

### Support accessing employment

- **Mitie** will be holding interviews for their **facilities** roles, following an Essential Skills workshop on **28<sup>th</sup> September**
- **OCS Global** will be holding interviews for their facilities and driving roles, following an Essential Skills workshop on **5<sup>th</sup> October**

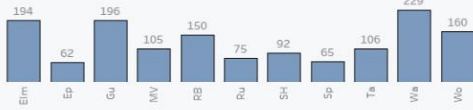

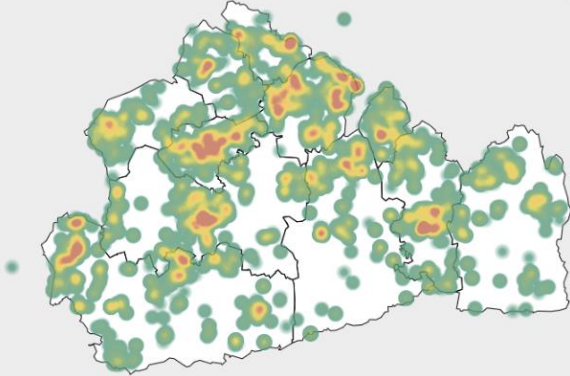

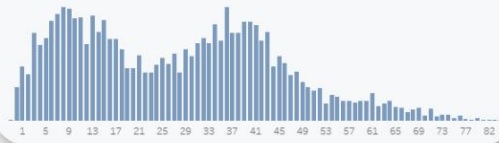
Density Map of Ukrainian Guests

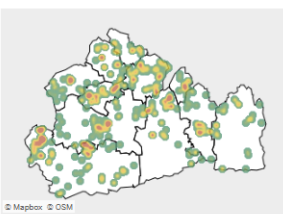

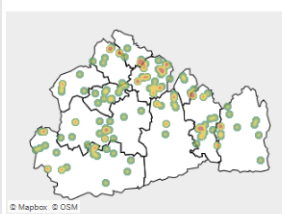
