Minutes

Minutes of previous meeting were passed as an accurate reflection of the meeting

Website

KM reported that the website continues to be regularly viewed but most members don't use it to keep in touch or produce pictures.

Treasurer's Report

DB presented the accounts for the year to 30th April 2015. The present balance in the business account was £4730.32 with £664.30 in the current account. There is still a shortage of collectors and deliverers. It was suggested that we try to attract new members via 'Vantage Point' and 'Round and About' and also via the Newsletter which we should try to deliver to all houses on a particular road rather than just to members for the same reason. Accounts were provided.

Fields Update

The follow-up letter/email to Waverley on the Fields has not been answered so PM to follow up. The letter concerned formal confirmation that the top part of the Hopfields would be preserved as a public open space in perpetuity to define the meaning of "lifetime of the development". It also sought to ask how this meaning would be incorporated into the legal agreement with the developer. SE continues to seek clarification on the status of other adjacent land such as an area to the south west, the fields to the north of the hopfields and the field behind Three Stiles Road. Much of this land had been ASVI and land further to the north had been of AGLV status, although this status had been ignored in both the Waverley and Town plans.

PM drew attention to a revised planning application for one house at the end of Three Stiles Road. This is still outside the present development boundary and into AGLV land. PM recommended continued objection and this was agreed.
